







- 1. Always wear a DOT-Compliant helmet, goggles, long sleeve protective shirt, long pants, over-the-ankle boots, and gloves,
- 2. Never ride on paved roads except to cross when done safely and permitted by law. Another vehicle could hit you. ATVs are designed to be operated off road.
- 3. Never ride under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- 4. Never carry a passenger on a single rider ATV, and no more than one passenger on any ATV that is specifically designed for two people.
- 5. Only ride an ATV that is designed for your age.
- 6. Supervise riders younger than 16. ATVs are not toys.
- 7. Ride only on designated trails and at a safe speed.
